Park installation for the historical ruined tower and destination of the town carnival procession, Weather or Not Festival. Tower installation consisting of two wire and paper 'weather gods' designed and created by local secondary school and rain drops installation created by local primary schools. Mentored young artist.

Drawing and clay modelling workshops with secondary school pupils designing two large wire and paper mache heads for installation on the park tower exterior walls.



Cutting and forming the wire mesh frames. Paper mache applied and sculpted.



Painting the heads and adding collage details.
